WHAT IS THE ART CLASS?

The Art Class is an extra-curricular enrichment programme in conjunction with the Royal Academy of Art in The Hague. Students from the Rijnlands Lyceum - International School Wassenaar, who have a real passion for art, have the opportunity to receive lessons at the Art Academy. Students go once a week accompanied by the coordinator of the Art Class. Once at the Art Academy they are taught by Academy teachers in art disciplines such as Photography, Graphic Design, Interactive Media Design and Ceramics to name a few.

It is a unique opportunity! Students not only develop their creative talents but also get an impression of what it would be like to study at an art academy. Even if you do not plan to study art after school, participating in the Art Class gives you the skills to think creatively, which is an asset in any profession.

WHAT DOES AN ART CLASS AFTER-NOON ENTAIL?

Every Wednesday afternoon you will go with the Art Class coordinator by coach to The Hague. The Art Class lessons last from 14:00 – 16:45, and you are taught by Academy teachers who are specialists in their field of art. The year is divided into five modules.

Each module consists of a different art discipline and you will work on assignments related to it. Sometimes you will be asked to do some research at home to develop ideas ready for the next lesson.

Art Class students are encouraged to discuss their ideas and what they are working on. Your teacher supervises you in helping you to develop your ideas and way of working.

At the end of each module your teacher will assess what you have produced. This is in the form of a grade and an explanation of why you have got that grade. The grades from the Art Class are independent from school grades; they do not appear on your school report.

WHEN DOES THE ART CLASS BEGIN?

The Art Class begins towards the end of September when students have had a chance to settle into school. Before the first Art Class lesson you and your parents/ guardians will visit the Academy for an Introduction Evening, where the programme for the year will be explained and you will have a guided tour of the building.

At the end of the Art Class year towards the end of May, all your pieces of work will be exhibited in a final show. It is a wonderful end to the year and family and friends are welcome to come and see what you have made!






ART AND CULTURE AT THE RIINLANDS

Are you creative and have an extra interest in art? Then the Rijnlands has lots to offer you! As well as extra-curricular programmes such as the Art Class and the Musical, the Rijnlands also organises a yearly Open Podium for singers and musicians to perform at. DOES THE ART CLASS APPEAL TO YOU?

Then apply for the Introduction Afternoon held at the Royal Academy of Art. On the ISW website you will find information. During the Introduction Afternoon you will receive a guided tour of the building and studios, do a drawing exercise and see the existing Art Class students at work.

If, after this afternoon, you are still interested, then apply to the Art Class coordinator for an interview.

It is important that you are aware that the Art Class is for students who have a broad interest in art. This is because it offers such a diverse range of artistic disciplines and techniques.

As an Art Class student you should be motivated to complete a whole year of lessons.

The Art Class takes place on Wednesday afternoons which means that you will miss one and sometimes two school lessons. It is therefore important that you can plan well.



WHAT ABOUT THE INTERVIEW?

After the Introduction Afternoon you can apply for an interview to join the Art Class. The interview will be conducted by the Art Class coordinator and a teacher from the Art Academy. In the interview you are expected to show at least twenty pieces of work in a wide variety of media and techniques. Of course you do not need to be proficient at all the different types of art available. We do however want to see that you are prepared to experiment and that you are motivated and enthusiastic.

Next to drawings, consider bringing pieces of work in media such as:

- Animations/films/ other digital works
- Photographs / photo-collages
- Collages
- Works in textile
- Three-dimensional works
- Sculptures made out of recycled items



COSTS

For your parents/guardians it is important to be aware that there are costs involved in participating in the Art Class.

The Royal Academy of Art charges € 425.00 per year.

Aside from this amount there are also the following costs:

- A one-off amount for personal basic art materials
- Contribution to the museum excursion
- Contribution towards the coach
