WHAT IS ART CLASS?

The Art Class is an enrichment program in collaboration with the Royal Academy of Art (KABK) in The Hague. Students from Rijnlands with a passion for art and creation are given the opportunity to participate in this extra curriculum.

Every week there are lessons both at RLW in Wassenaar and at the Royal Academy of Art in The Hague. The lessons are taught by teachers with specialized expertise.

A unique opportunity! You develop your creative talents and get an impression of what it would be like if you want to follow an art education in the future. Planning to do something completely different? Even then, skills like creative thinking are very useful.

WHAT DOES AN AFTERNOON IN ART CLASS LOOK LIKE?

The Art Class takes place on a fixed afternoon of the week, from 2:00 PM to 4:45 PM.

Each year, five (of the mentioned) modules are offered, allowing you to explore a wide range of techniques and art forms. For each module, you will work on several assignments during the lessons. Sometimes, you also get the chance to refine your ideas at home.

You are encouraged to actively engage with your teachers about your work. They guide you in developing your ideas. At the end of each module, your work is assessed and explained.

Good to know: these assessments of the Art Class are independent of your school grades and will not appear on your report.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

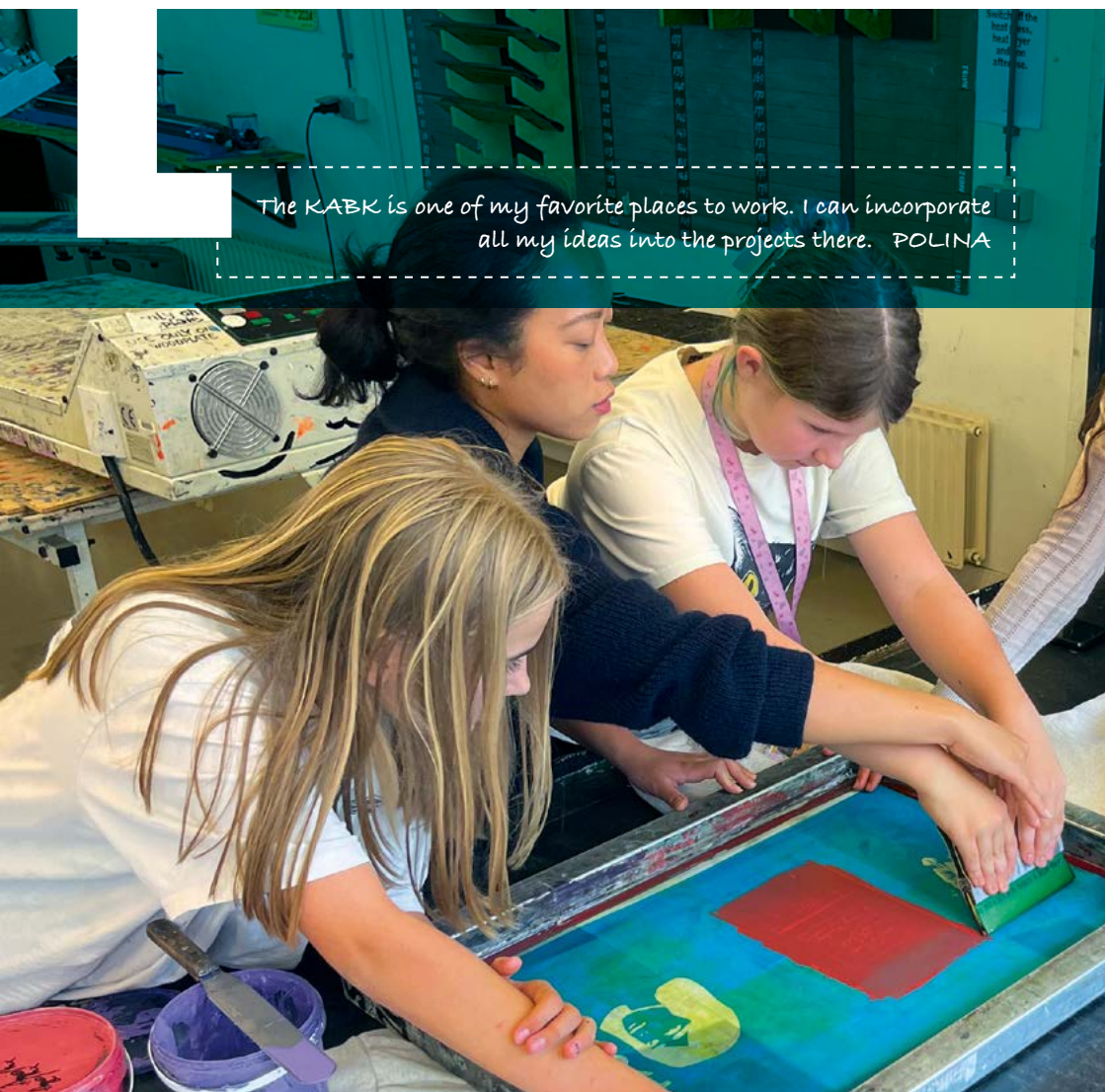
What do we expect from you? In the Art Class, you will explore various art forms. We're looking for students with a broad interest in art. The Art Class takes place during school hours, meaning you might miss a regular class occasionally. Good planning skills will therefore be helpful.

HOW DOES THE ADMISSION PROCESS WORK?

During the admission interview, you will present your own work. Of course, we know you aren't a fully developed artist yet, but enthusiasm and motivation are important. Show that you're willing to experiment with ideas and techniques. Bring at least 20 pieces of work created with different media. In addition to drawings, think of:

- Animations, videos, digital works
- Photos, collages
- 3D work, textiles, work with recycled materials

Your parents can help you bring the work to school. The interviews will take place at RLW Wasenaar. While you meet with the teachers, your parents can wait at the school. You will receive an email within 2 weeks informing you whether you have been admitted.
